Local market signings.....

Pahang, Malaysia

ESC Projects (M) Sdn Bhd has secured another order of 3.0 metre long ESC8BP sheet piles for the JPS project in the royal town of Pekan, Pahang, Malaysia for WMA Resources Sdn Bhd. The lightweight and custom length allows the contractor to realise cost savings by not having to cut the materials on site or incur wastage. The sheet piles will be delivered in the finished lengths ready for installation.

Toyota Showroom Project

ESC Projects (M) Sdn Bhd has been awarded a contract for the supply and installation of sheet piles and strutting system to protect the existing neighbouring building. A 7m deep excavation shall be carried out for the installation of M&E services for the showroom.

Highest ESC Sheet Piles Installation Project

ESC Projects (M) Sdn Bhd has been awarded a contract to supply sheet piles to reinstate a collapsed slope 3400 ft above sea level near the peak of Gunung Ledang. The installation became necessary to protect the existing Celcom communication tower which is only a few metres away from the collapsed slope. Due to many sharp turns going up the hill, the sheet piles were supplied in 4m lengths and were joined to final length on site. Close cooperation with the Consultant and the Contractor has assured a successful completion of the project and allows ESC sheet piles to claim its highest installation ever in Malaysia.
